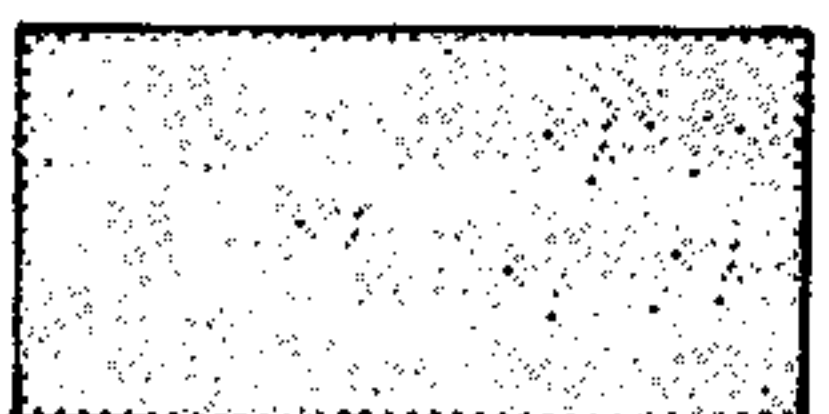

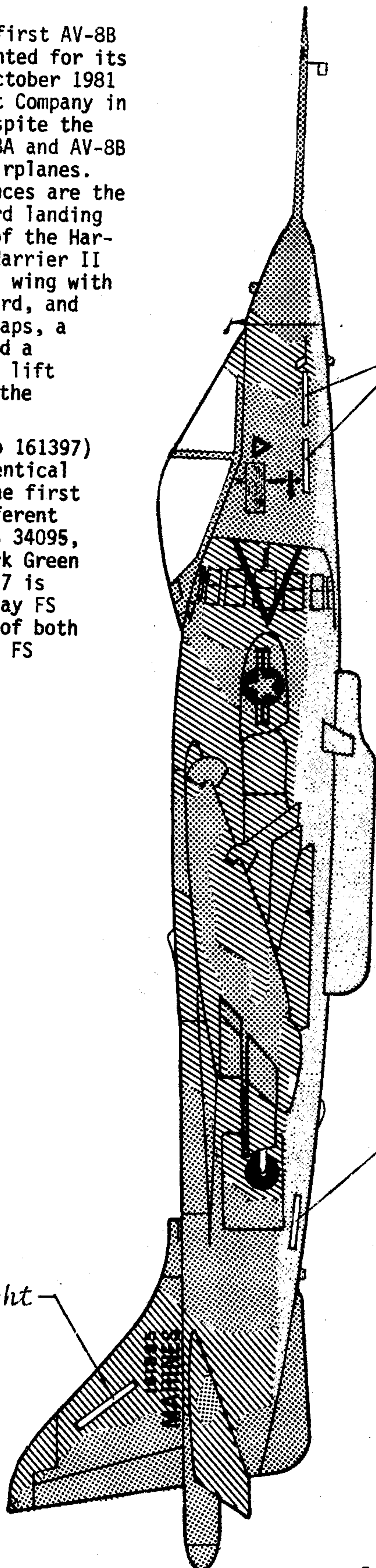
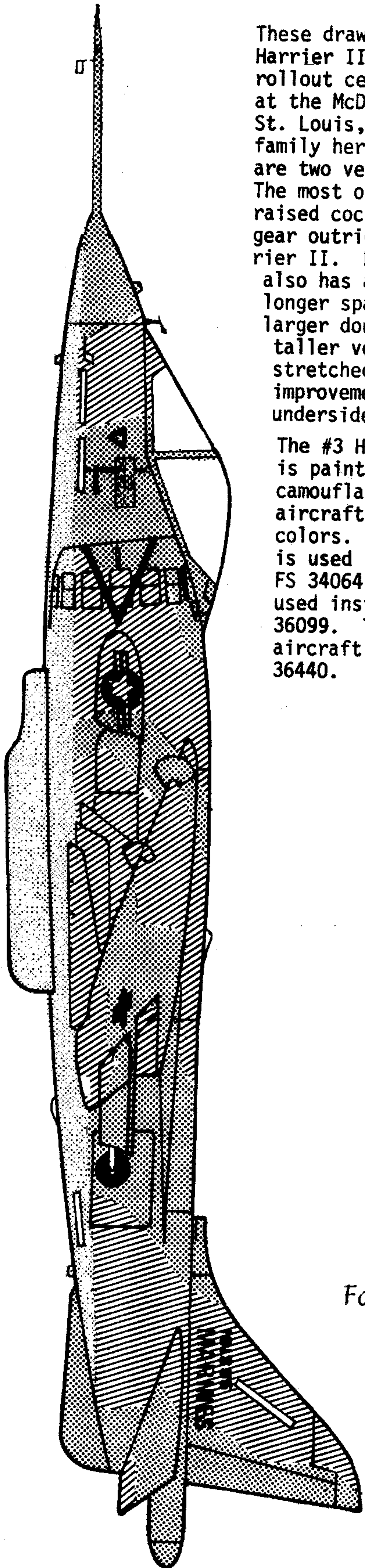

These drawings show the first AV-8B Harrier II as it was painted for its rollout ceremony on 16 October 1981 at the McDonnell Aircraft Company in St. Louis, Missouri. Despite the family heritage, the AV-8A and AV-8B are two very different airplanes. The most obvious differences are the raised cockpit and inboard landing gear outrigger location of the Harrier II. But the AV-8B Harrier II also has a new composite wing with longer span, broader chord, and larger double slotted flaps, a taller vertical tail and a stretched fuselage with lift improvement devices on the underside.

The #3 Harrier II (BuNo 161397) is painted with the identical camouflage scheme as the first aircraft, but uses different colors. Dark Green, FS 34095, is used in place of Dark Green FS 34064. Blue FS 35237 is used instead of Dark Gray FS 36099. The undersides of both aircraft are Light Gray FS 36440.
